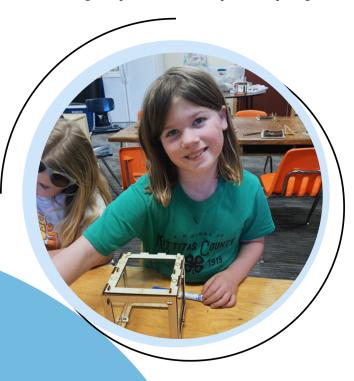


Kittitas County

Our Goals:

- Youth Development: We aim to provide a safe, supportive environment where young people can develop essential life skills, leadership abilities, and positive relationships with peers and adults.
- Academic Success: Our programs focus on helping young people achieve academic success by providing homework assistance, tutoring, educational enrichment activities, and access to resources that support learning and skill development.
- Healthy Lifestyles: We promote the

What We Do:

- Address the lack of safe out-of-school spaces for children in Kittitas, deemed a "daycare desert."
- Support families by providing after-school and summer care, free meals, educational enrichment, and caring adult mentors.
- Increase school engagement, extend learning, and build a stronger, supported community where youth thrive.

Programs We Offer

- After-School Club: Operates from 2:30 to 6:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, providing constructive and supportive environments for kindergarteners to fifthgraders.
- Spring Break Camp: This successful camp offers various activities, from cooking classes to art and STEM projects.
- Mentoring: Dedicated mentors ignite dreams, introduce youth to new passions, and provide academic assistance and social-emotional support.
- Educational Support: Homework help, tutoring sessions, and literacy promotion to transform academic struggles into hope and future plans.
- Nutritional Support: Providing nourishing meals and snacks to combat hunger and promote well-being.
- Fine Arts Programming: Cultural Arts and Arts and Crafts classes for creative expression and skill-building.
- STEAM/STEM Programs: Experiences foster interest and skills in science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics.
- Healthy Lifestyle Promotion: Lessons on developing healthy relationships, money management, and fostering healthy lifestyles.
